

What We're Learning Next



<u>Writing:</u> The rest of the nine weeks we will continue to work on personal narratives. AKS: Write narratives in which they recount a well-elaborated event or short sequence of events, include details to describe actions, thoughts, and feelings, use temporal words to signal event order, and provide a sense of closure (CCGPS) (2LA D2012-24)

<u>Math:</u> We will wrap up our part 1 unit on base 10. AKS: Explain that the three digits of a three-digit number represent amounts of hundreds, tens, and ones (e.g., 706 equals 7 hundreds, 0 tens, and 6 ones) (CCOPS) (2MA_B2012-7)

<u>Science:</u> We will finish learning about the life cycle of a plant.

AKS: investigate the life cycles of different organisms to understand the diversi of life. (OPS) (2SC_D2007-13)

Social Studies: We will begin to explore the lives of James Oglethorpe, Mary Musgrave, and Tomochichi. AKS: Describe the cultural and geographic systems associated with James Oglethorpe, Tomochichi, and Mary Musgrove (OPS) (2SS D2008-21)
